AK was in discussion with BaNES.</p> <p><b>Footpath</b> – from Rag Hill corner to Braysdown – major works to the ditch and footpath to be carried out in the Summer.</p> <p>D) <b>School</b> -</p> <p>E) <b>Highways</b> GH - White lines still not painted despite having been reported to BaNES over eighteen months ago. Complaints had been received from residents about the repairs already carried out in Green Lane and Single Hill by BaNES.
